ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION (ENVE)

ENVE 520 Introduction to Environmental Education 3 Hours

This course will provide students with an introduction to the field of environmental education, including basic history and philosophy, methodologies, resources for educators, and current trends in the field. *Recent Term*(s) Offered: fall 2022; spring 2024; summer 2024

ENVE 560 Investigating and Evaluating Environmental Issues 3 Hours

Specifically designed for teachers and other educators, course focuses on the identification and evaluation of specific environmental issues, leading to possible environmental/service action projects by their students, with attention to the potential outcomes of such projects on the physical environment, other humans, and other living things. *Recent Term(s) Offered: fall 2023*

ENVE 580 Instructional Strategies in Environmental Education 3 Hours

Specific teaching strategies associated with the field of environmental education programs will be addressed, with an emphasis on active, experiential learning. Portions of the course are taught in field settings. Students are responsible for arranging their own transportation to designated or assigned sites.

ENVE 585 Special Topics in Environmental Education 1-3 Hours (repeatable max of 6 hrs)
